

Safety Measures at MoLI Events

We're delighted you've chosen the museum for your special event. As Covid-19 is still present in the community, your safety is our priority. To make sure we all stay safe, please take note of the following safety measures and restrictions for events at MoLI:



Clean your hands

Hand-sanitiser stations are located throughout the museum



Keep your distance

Please maintain a 2m distance from others



Be kind to our staff

They are working to keep us all safe! Rudeness to staff is treated as a safety risk and will not be tolerated at the museum – offending visitors will be asked to leave the premises

A safe event space

- » All event equipment is disinfected before and after each event (tables, chairs, etc.)
- » Accessible hand sanitiser is available in all event spaces at all times
- » No handling of visitors coats/bags by MoLI staff

Smaller gatherings

- » In phase with government social distancing guidelines, event capacities are (at present) reduced to 50% of usual capacity

Social distancing

- » Guests must adhere to 2 metre distancing
- » A safe queue system will be in place at entry/exit
- » For events in No.85, we encourage the use of our separate on-street entrance on St Stephen's Green

Contact tracing

- » To facilitate contact tracing, we are required to record contact details for all event guests. Details will be stored for a maximum of one month in line with GDPR regulations.

Hygiene

- » Guests are asked to adhere to safe hygiene standards – cleaning hands regularly, wearing a mask if coughing or sneezing

AV equipment

- » No AV equipment will be handled by guests
- » Use of the podium microphone only

Relax, chat & network

- » As restrictions ease, the time will come for us all to interact & socialise in person in a safe and joyful environment. We are keeping up to date on all safety guidelines from government and NPHET, and will adjust our safety measures accordingly
